

# Rehabilitation of the Rosa Mota Pavilion

## Summary

Renovation and reconversion of the existing pavilion into a multi-purpose venue and landmark for event hosting. Flexible and scalable up to 8000 people for large entertainment & music events, and up to 5500 for Corporate & MICE events (including a 2,400 sq. mt. column free exhibition hall), it will be a major touristic attraction. With an overall investment of 8 M€ is expected to open late 2019.

## Presentation

Rosa Mota Pavilion was built in 1951. With the rehabilitation works, which started in 2017 and will end in October 2019, the pavilion will be equipped with the most modern technologies to accommodate large business, cultural and sport events. The project will give new life to the pavilion, which was in an advanced state of deterioration, respecting the building's emblematic architecture.

With this project, a new centrality will be created in the city, serving as an aggregator of other nearby and relevant infrastructures such as the Cristal Palace Gardens, the Rose Garden House, the Almeida Garrett Library or the Romantic Museum. It has great potential for supporting tourism growth, allowing Porto to host large events of international dimension.

After a tendering procedure launched by Porto City Hall, a private consortium will rehabilitate and manage the pavilion during 20 years.
